

# *Educational Tour for I B. Tech Students Organized by H&S Department*



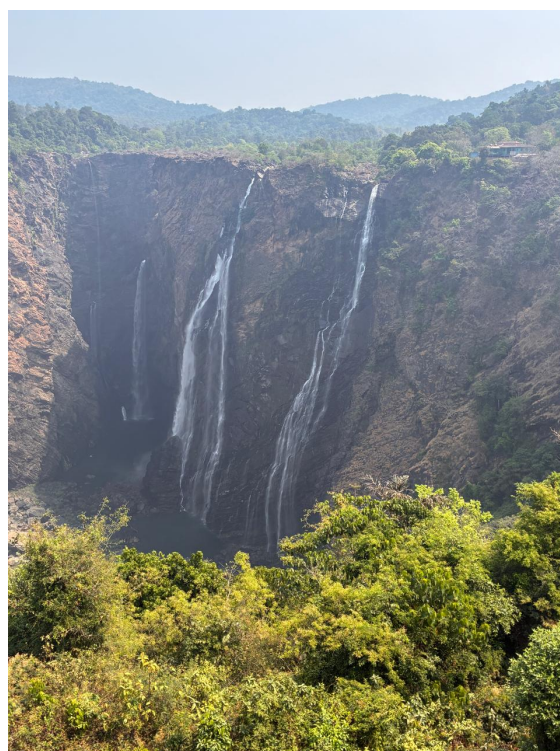

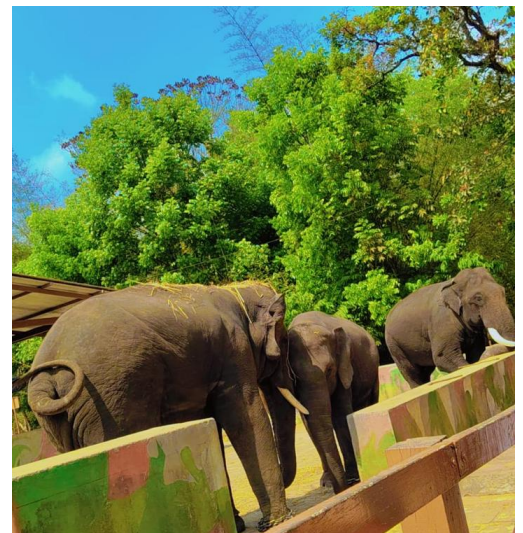
